



- Private, selective research university in upstate New York
- Co-educational, non-sectarian institution offering baccalaureate, master's and research doctorate degrees
- Enrollment: Undergraduate = 5,100; Graduate = 1,500
- Average SAT: 1350
- 64% of freshmen come from top 10% of their HS class (95% are from the top 25%)
- Retention rate 92% and graduation rate 82%
- STEM dominant (science, technology, engineering, mathematics) – approximately 80% students in these fields

# Institutional Research

- Data Collected
  - Longitudinal analyses from entering freshman survey (student orientation) to freshman follow-up survey (April of freshman year) to senior exit survey (upon graduation)
  - ACHA/NCHA survey
