### SPRC Launches Prevention Information by Audience

In an ongoing effort to inform as many people as possible about preventing suicide, the Suicide Prevention Resource Center (SPRC) has launched a series of web pages geared for specific audiences. For each audience, a page has been created that contains information on recognizing and responding to warning signs, and includes links to resource materials, such as programs, useful websites and further reading, for that population. Each audience page is also available as a pdf document, which can be freely reproduced and distributed by the public. SPRC will continue to add audience pages to the website over the coming months.
