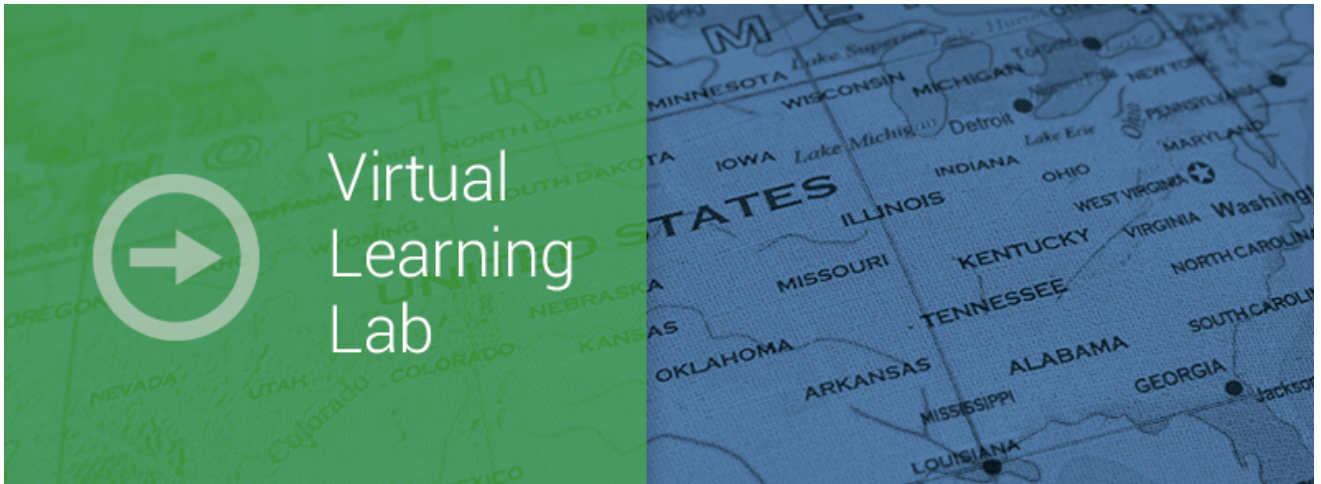




Virtual Learning Lab: State Suicide Prevention
