

Involve Stakeholders

It's important to include staff from other departments who will be (or may need to be) involved if a suicide attempt or a suicide occurs or if a student is in crisis. It is also helpful to engage relevant off-campus stakeholders, as well as a few students to ensure your protocols include their perspectives. Depending on their availability, you may want to them in one or more of the following tasks:

- Developing or revising protocols
- Reviewing and/or approving protocols
- Disseminating and/or using protocols
